DISABILTY ACCESS OFFICER

The Appointed Disability Access Officer for the club shall be **Nick Frankland**.

The Disability Access Officer is the person responsible in the first instance as a point of contact for spectators who are disabled and/or their personal assistants.

The Disability Access Officer may be contacted prior to, during or after matches in relation to information or support requests and the Club will endeavour to facilitate any reasonable requests.
